- Must have lived on Campus Residence at the time of nomination or plan on living on Residence by the start of their first term in office
- Be responsible for gathering information, tracking legislation and conducting research on issues and policies concerning campus residence student life.
- Be an advocate for students living on campus, specifically in Algoma U Sault Ste Marie Campus and to advocate for a safe, open environment when necessary
- Will focus on target areas of Academic success for those living in residence, ensuring that proper resources are available and accessible to these students. These can include but are not limited to concerns about Food security, Student life programming in residence and Health and well-being (physical, mental, etc.) of students residing on campus, housing prices
- Will be required to liaise with Campus Residence advisors, Residence council, Residence life staff, the Director of Student Experience and Manager of Student Success
- Will support campaigns and be an advocate for accessible and affordable services and resources on campus, for example mandatory meal plans and food service, accessible hours to computer labs, library, kitchen areas etc., access to grocery and food stores, reliable transit service
- Raise concerns and be a leader for residence life programming
- Be knowledgeable about living conditions and raise concerns about structural and maintenance issues, as well as response time and satisfaction from Physical Plant/Algoma U administration.
- Consult with campus residential students and other stakeholders regarding changes and policies being made in dormitories.
- Be knowledgeable about appeals and disciplinary processes for campus residences and advocate for fair treatment of students

Additional Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Shall obtain voting rights to Board & Organizational decisions
- Representatives must be knowledgeable and willing to promote AUSU events and services.
- Representatives must complete 3-6 hours per month to attend meetings and service their constituencies needs.
- Representatives must set an example for students at all times
- Representatives must base all decisions on what is best for the organization and the students.
- Representatives must obtain feedback from all stakeholders on projects and board issues.
- Representatives are responsible to prepare a report for each board meeting.
- Representatives will sit on committees and councils as necessary.
- Representatives will come prepared to all meetings by reviewing the agenda, support material, and any additional research that may be needed.
- Representatives must attend all monthly board meetings, executive, team & planning meetings, as well as others as needed
- Shall perform any other duties that are in the best interest of AUSU, as approved and/or as mandated by the Board, its By-laws, policies and/or members.
- Must be in good Academic Standing and enrolled in at least one course per semester at Algoma University
- Service is required from May 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 to April 30 2022
- Remuneration for councillors will be paid by honorarium each semester, however the successful students' will receive recognition on their Cocurricular Records for Service on the AUSU Board as well as references for future employment and consideration for future AUSU positions
